**7:30 pm** Action Item 2: On March 19<sup>th</sup>, the Tierrasanta Community Council voted to convene the by-laws committee in order to respond to proposed changes by the City of San Diego Community Planners Committee and the City Attorney's office for all planning groups subject to Council Policy 600-24. Since the adjournment of the last TCC meeting, the fact that the TCC's corporate bylaws updated in 2011 and the TCC's community planning group bylaws updated in 2008 are inconsistent with each other because the Tierrasanta Open Space Committee and the Tierrasanta Recreation Council are listed as Standing Committees in the corporate bylaws but are not listed as Standing Committees in the planning group bylaws. Tonight's action is to discuss the current structure of the <u>Tierrasanta</u> Community Council and the community's committees and <u>refer the matter to the Bylaws</u> <u>Committee</u>.

**7:50 pm** Action Item 3: An application for a Process 3 Conditional Use Permit (CUP) has been filed to amend an existing permit at 10791 Tierrasanta Blvd. (Newbreak Church), for an educational facility (kindergarten to 5<sup>th</sup> grade) in the existing building. Tonight a representative from Newbreak Church will describe the process and answer questions. A traffic study will be done for the proposed project. This is an information only item tonight. The planning group will vote to make an advisory recommendation to the City of San Diego in the future. Under a Process 3 review, the application and plans are submitted to the City where they are reviewed by City staff. A Hearing Officer considers the information and issues a decision. The decision can be appealed to the City Planning Commission. The Planning Commission's decision may also be appealed to the Planning Commission. The City Council does not vote on whether a project under Process 3 proceeds or not. Tonight's action is to hear from a representative of Newbreak Church and enable the public to ask questions, etc. The matter will be referred to a future TCC meeting for a proposed recommendation to the Hearing Officer.
