The Tierrasanta Open Space Committee is advisory to the City of San Diego Open Space Division on matters related to the Tierrasanta Open Space Maintenance Assessment District (MAD).

- 7 pm Chair Deanna Spehn called the meeting to order; Quorum was present; No introductions needed as everyone knew each other; Agenda review. Chair Spehn asked that a public art application be added to the agenda since the Committee would not meet again until September.
 - 1. **Non-Agenda Public Comment**: limited to 3 minutes per person on subjects under the jurisdiction of this committee but not on the agenda

Bob Lang:

- Numerous Tierrasanta trails have been degraded by erosion. Recommended trail maintenance become a priority in the upcoming open space budget. The recent application of decomposed granite (DG) on the East Shepherd Canyon Maintenance trail was most welcomed, but approximately 50 yards more of DG is needed and inquired if there is a plan or schedule for additional DG.
- The water level in Dishwasher Pond has dropped more than two feet below the spillway level. Reed bases are now exposed. Lang would like to see a Dishwasher Pond Community work day in early October to clear debris and pull dead reeds. The water level should be down an additional two or three feet by then.
- With the exception of a three week period in March, the base of the blue Water Dept. fixture on the Maintenance Path has leaked water continuously for seven months. Now moss is growing.
- Additional doggie bag dispensers are needed along the Maintenance Path down in the canyon because of the number of entrances to the canyon. Dog poop can be found along the trail.

Lee Campbell:

• Campbell is helping the Tierrasanta Foundation with electrical for the upcoming Old Time Rock and Roll event. He found out that outside events can no longer plug into the electrical and are to provide a generator if electricity is needed.

Sheldon Zemen:

- The condition of the fields has not been signed off yet so there is no definite date when the playing fields will re-open. Kevin Cook retired and had not signed off on the project before he left.
- 2. Approval of the Draft Minutes for the May 4, 2016 Meeting trailed to next meeting
- 3. Election of Secretary for a 2-year period beginning May 2016 Dawn Nielsen-Lostritto volunteered to be Secretary. Betty Ogilvie moved to appoint Dawn Nielsen-Lostritto as secretary, and Deanna Spehn seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.
- 4. Staff Report for July 6, 2016 meeting Bob Smith (see attached)

In addition to staff report (attached), Bob would like to replant areas on Tierrasanta Blvd and Clairemont Mesa Blvd medians to include yellow lantana and Raphiolepis. Nielsen said she'd like to see Raphiolepis variety used which would not require future pruning and to look at a dwarf variety.

Split rail fencing on Clairemont Mesa Blvd in front of the Recreation Center. Some of is falling apart and needs to be replaced. Deanna said the original railing was placed because people would walk down the hill from the Recreation Center creating a hazard from jaywalking across Clairemont Mesa Blvd. Replacement would be round fencing as found on the trails. The committee found this acceptable.

5. **Potential bylaws changes** for Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning Group that would impact this committee. The following is the section of the draft bylaws for the planning group that were scheduled to be discussed on Tuesday, July 5th prior to a proposed vote on the draft bylaws on Wednesday, July 20, 2016 at 6:30 pm at the Tierrasanta Recreation Center, 11220 Clairemont Mesa Blvd.

b) Committees/Subcommittees

The Tierrasanta Community Council may establish standing and ad hoc committees/*subcommittees* when their operation contributes to more effective discussions at regular planning group meetings.

(i) Standing Committees. Pursuant to the purpose of the Tierrasanta Community Council as identified in Article II, Section 1, the planning group has established the following standing committees:

a) Community Development Committee, <u>consisting of nine (9) members, five (5) members</u> of which shall be voting members of the Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning <u>Group</u>, which meets as required to review discretionary projects and provides written recommendations *on same* to the Tierrasanta Community Council. b) Tierrasanta Election Committee, which meets as required to draft the Standing Order of specific election procedures for the election cycle and provides this to the Tierrasanta Community Council for approval.

c) Tierrasanta Open Space Committee, also known as the Tierrasanta Open Space Maintenance Assessment District Committee, consisting of thirteen (13) members, seven (7) of which shall be voting members of the Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning Group, which meets as required to provide advice and counsel to the Open Space Division of the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of San Diego.

(ii) Ad Hoc Committees. Ad hoc committees may be established for finite period of time to review more focused issue areas and shall be disbanded following their review.
a) Tierrasanta Election Committee, which meets as required to draft the Standing Order of specific election procedures for the election cycle and provides this to the Tierrasanta Community Council for approval. The Chair and members of the Election Committee shall be approved by the Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning Group.

(iii) Committee Composition. Committees shall contain a majority of members who are: members of the planning group, or who previously served as members of the planning group and who have completed mandatory training on Council Policy 600-24.

Non-members, who are duly appointed by a planning group to serve on a committee, may be indemnified by the City in accordance with Ordinance No. Θ -17086 O-19883 NS, and any future amendments thereto, provided they satisfy any and all requirements of the Administrative Guidelines.

(iv) Recommendations. Committee recommendations must be brought forth to the full planning group for formal vote at a noticed public meeting. In no case may a committee or committee recommendation be forwarded directly to the City as the formal recommendation of the planning group without a formal vote of the full planning group.

May 14 - Clean up East Shepherd Canyon - East End. 9 volunteers removed 600 feet of pipe and numerous same eucalyptus saplings.

June 11 - 15 volunteers removed large Acacia west of Dishwasher pond.
