- **Open Space Trails Plan** - Staff is preparing responses to questions asked by the agencies after their site visit on October 22, 2015. Laura Ball will be attending the January 4, 2017 Open Space meeting, to discuss the Trail Plans.
- **Service Road**- Treebeard will be adding DG, and making improvements to the service road in Shepherds Canyon during the month of January, weather permitting.

Landscape Contract

- **Treebeard** - continues to provide services within budget.

Miscellaneous

- New landscaping of native plants that consists of Mint Marigold Tagetes, Rosea Autumn Sage, Hot Lips Sage, Furman's Red Sage, Pink Muhly, California Brittlebush Encelia, Imperial Blue Plumbago and new mulch at the northeast Corner of Antigua and Santo Road.
- New landscaping on west side of Viacha Drive Green Belt with Gold Lantana, Orange Day Lily, Blue Agapanthus and added new mulch.
- On Saturday December 10th, the Friends of Tierrasanta Canyons cut Eucalyptus trees in the east end of Shepherd Canyon at the northwest corner of Tierrasanta Recreation Center.
