STAFF REPORT**

Landscape Maintenance

- Treebeard continues to provide landscape maintenance services in a timely manner and within budget. Turf fields are ready for school and sports activities.

Tree Maintenance

- Clairemont Mesa Blvd. tree pruning has begun and will continue. Community Park tree pruning has begun and will continue behind the tennis courts and swimming pool. Some trees have been pruned in Rueda Canyon. Failed Coral tree at Roadrunner Park has been safety pruned. Roadrunner Park is scheduled for tree trimming in September.

Open Space Canyons

- San Diego Canyonlands will be working in the Open Space Canyons throughout the year. Eric Bowlby will be present at the OS Committee meeting Wednesday, September 6th to provide further details.
- The City of San Diego brush crew has been working to clear fire hazard plant material in Tierrasanta. They will finish in the next couple of weeks.
- On Saturday August 12th, the Friends of Tierrasanta along with San Diego Canyonlands removed French Broom from Rueda Canyon. They continue to treat invasive weeds.

Miscellaneous

- Drainage swale (Concrete V-Ditch) has been replaced on Matador Ct. to eliminate standing water and to allow the storm drain to flow into the canyon naturally.
- Solar panels have been installed at the Junipero Serra High School parking lot. Final construction and electrical work will be completed in September.
- Community Park will be installing solar panels in the upper parking lot. Construction has begun. The lower parking lot or overflow parking at Gaspar de Portola Middle School is available.

- Water pipes have been installed on Clairemont Mesa Blvd. Construction and lane closures will continue in September.
- Communication wires are being installed in neighborhoods off Antigua Blvd. near Vista Grande Elementary School.
- Mission Trails Regional Park Tierrasanta Entrance at the end of Clairemont Mesa Blvd. has been damaged again. MTRP has requested bids from vendors to repair/replace the pipe gate and wood pillars that were damaged.
