

THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT OPEN SPACE DIVISION TIERRASANTA MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT October 4, 2017 STAFF REPORT

Landscape Maintenance

- Treebeard continues to provide landscape maintenance services in a timely manner and within budget. Turf fields are actively used by many User Groups.
- Irrigation wiring across Clairemont Mesa Blvd as well as at Tierrasanta Community Park have been hit by different construction crews. Both have been repaired and are functional again.

Tree Maintenance

- Clairemont Mesa Blvd. tree pruning has been completed on the center medians. Community
 Park tree pruning has been completed behind the tennis courts and swimming pool. Roadrunner
 Park tree trimming has been completed.
- Tierrasanta Blvd center medians are currently being safety pruned. Villa Norte Park tree trimming has begun.

Open Space Canyons

- The City of San Diego brush crew has completed the Tierrasanta fire hazard weed abatement.
- On Saturday September 16th, the Friends of Tierrasanta in coordination with I Love A Clean San Diego (ILACSD) filled a 40 yard dumpster of eucalyptus suckers and fallen debris from behind the tennis courts at Tierrasanta Community Park. They continue to treat invasive weeds.
- Dishwasher Pond water has been filled and the level has been maintained.
- The Scour Pond in East Shepard Canyon has a potential construction improvement project in the planning phase. Glenn Christensen from Ahtna Construction will be present in November to speak to the Open Space Committee.
- San Diego Canyonlands (SDCL) is on track with the Rueda Canyon palm removal project for December 2017.
- Mission Trails Regional Park has received bids from vendors and is waiting for a Purchase
 Order to proceed with the repair of the damaged pipe gate and wood pillars at the park entrance
 on Clairemont Mesa Blvd.

Miscellaneous

- Final construction and electrical work on solar panels at Junipero Serra High School is almost complete.
- Solar panels installation at Tierrasanta Community Park continues in the upper parking lot. The lower parking lot or overflow parking at Gaspar de Portola Middle School is available.
- Water pipes have been installed on Clairemont Mesa Blvd. Construction and lane closures will continue in October.
- Biannual Storm Drain inspections and reports have been completed in both developed and undeveloped areas in Tierrasanta.
- Tierrasanta Community Park sports field lighting improvement project will begin soon. A preconstruction meeting occurred in September.
- Playground equipment inspections have occurred at all parks in Tierrasanta. Some structures
 have been repaired while other items are scheduled for repair by the City of San Diego
 Community Parks.
