Landscape Maintenance

- Treebeard continues to provide landscape maintenance services in a timely manner and within budget.
- Irrigation upgrades on Clairemont Mesa Blvd center islands have taken place in May.
 Mollendo Blvd to Santo Rd center island near De Portola Middle School had new drip lines installed. Additional plant material and mulch to follow.

- A new controller was installed at the last island on CMB from Rueda Dr. to MTRP.
- Mulch has been added to center medians along Santo Rd. and Tierrasanta Blvd. in preparation for the May 19 parade.

Tree Maintenance

- Trees have been safety pruned along Clairemont Mesa Blvd. center medians and rightof-ways.
- Safety pruning continues at various locations including Open Space overlooks and culde-sacs.

Open Space Canyons

- Friends of Tierrasanta Canyons planted 20 coast live oak trees at the Lower North Shepherd Canyon trail by Santo Rd. and Antigua Blvd. on Saturday May 12^{st.}
- Irrigation drip lines were installed to help facilitate watering.
- Many existing tree stumps in this area were cut lower to help make this corner more presentable.
- Dishwasher Pond water has remained full due to the recent rains.
- Mulch has been added to several Open Space overlooks and cul-de-sacs as well.

Miscellaneous

- GET-IT-DONE is a valuable tool for reporting many City issues. This form of reporting helps the issue get referred to the correct department to address. I encourage everyone to become familiar with GET-IT-DONE which is available on the City homepage at www.sandiego.gov or available as an application for smartphones.
- Tierrasanta Recreation Center roof repairs have completed. Air conditioning installation is currently underway.
- Tierrasanta Sports Field Lighting Phase II: Work will likely take place this August or September. No new information available at this time.
- ADA compliant sidewalks are being installed by the playground access at Tierrasanta Community Park.
- Roadrunner Park slide has been closed due to unsafe surface cracks. New parts are on order and a work order has been submitted.
