September 3, 2018 STAFF REPORT

Landscape Maintenance

- Treebeard continues to provide landscape maintenance services in a timely manner and within budget.
- Curbs at Tierrasanta Community Park and MTRP have been repainted.
- Gopher holes have been filled at Vista Grande Elementary School field.
- All turf fields are ready for school and sports use.

Tree Maintenance

- Trees have been safety pruned along lower Tierrasanta Blvd right-of-ways.
- Tree trimming and safety pruning continues at various locations including Open Space overlooks and cul-de-sacs.
- Eucalyptus trees have been pruned in the open space behind Farb Middle School prior to school beginning.
- Tierrasanta Sports Field Lighting Phase II: Work will likely take place this August or September. No new information available at this time.

Open Space Canyons

- Dishwasher Pond water has been maintained at an adequate level.
- Mulch has been added to several Open Space overlooks and cul-de-sacs.
- Unexploded ordnance signs are being assessed and replaced as needed.

Miscellaneous

- GET-IT-DONE is a valuable tool for reporting many City issues. This form of reporting helps the issue get referred to the correct department to address. I encourage everyone to become familiar with GET-IT-DONE which is available on the City homepage at www.sandiego.gov or available as an application for smartphones.
- Roadrunner Park slide is still closed, but some progress is underway. The manufacturer is tentatively scheduled to receive parts from its specialty supplier in September. Installation will be scheduled once all parts are in hand. This slide has been closed for a few months.
- Engineered Wood Fiber product (wood chips) is needed at Roadrunner Park and Tierrasanta Community Park to maintain safe surface levels. Newer samples of this material are available to present. A decision needs to be made so that we can bring these parks to satisfactory levels.
