AUGUST ACTIVITIES IN TIERRASANTA

Landscape Maintenance

- Treebeard continues to provide landscape maintenance services in a timely manner and within budget.
- All Joint-Use fields have been prepared for school and sports teams. The focus this month has been to get these fields ready for another school year and season of sports.
- Gopher trapping at Vista Grande is now complete. All traps have been removed.
- Low spots and dog holes in turf have been filled in.
- DG tracks at Farb, Deportola, Kumeyaay, and Vista Grande have been leveled and low spots filled in.
- New sod in bare areas of Serra HS, Deportola, and Community Park has rooted and is growing really well. This was installed in June and July.
- Irrigation heads on many fields were upgraded this year. All systems were run and adjusted for coverage to keep the grass green.
- Irrigation has been upgraded to Netafim drip lines in the center island on Clairemont Mesa Blvd from Antigua Blvd to Santo Rd. A few more plants and organic mulch will be added.

Tree Maintenance

- No downed trees to report on City of San Diego land in the Tierrasanta MAD.
- Structural and safety tree pruning will resume now that bird nesting season is ending (9/15).
- Look for more tree plantings in medians, rights-of-ways, and open space areas this year.

Open Space Canyons

- Friends of Tierrasanta continue their weekly cleanup. Old, unused irrigation pipe removal is now taking place in Rueda Canyon.
- Weekly Weeders group has been busy in in Shepherd Canyon by the Norte sign pulling invasive & non-native weeds.
- Invasive stinkwort weeds were treated on Shepherd Canyon Trail from Antigua to Villarica before they go to seed. This will help to keep the seedbank low for next year.
