Background

As part of the City of San Diego's commitment to improving the quality of life in all neighborhoods, the City is completing the design of a project that will replace or rehabilitate more than 1,300 linear feet of sewer pipe and replace about 17,000 linear feet of aging and deteriorating water pipes servicing your community. The new sewer and water distribution pipelines will bring the existing mains up to modern standards, accommodate community growth, and reduce maintenance requirements.

A location map illustrating the project area is enclosed with this notice.

Project Overview

This project is located in the Tierrasanta community area, Council District 7, and includes the following improvements:

- Replace-in-place 310 linear feet of sewer main;
- Rehabilitate 1,000 linear feet of sewer main;
- Replace in place 7,100 linear feet of water main;
- Install 9,900 linear feet of water main within a new trench and new alignment;
- Abandon 9,300 linear feet of existing water main;
- All other associated work, including fire hydrants, manholes, street resurfacing, curb ramps, etc; and
- Use of best management practices (BMPs) for prevention of storm water pollution during construction.

This project supports the City's sustainability and climate action goals of reducing the City's carbon footprint, increasing efficiencies, and improving quality of life.

Project Schedule

Construction: Fall 2021 through Fall 2023*

Project Budget

The project's planning, design and construction budget is \$11 million.*


