Linda Welch is asking about Villa Monserate Park re-opening as soon as possible. Vic Vettiyil explained that it's still closed in order for the plants to establish themselves per the contractor's recommendations. Emily Whittemore suggested fencing off only the plants and opening the playground to stop kids jumping the fence.
