A low administrative overhead of 1.5%.

Healthcare, Food Insecurity & Child Care

- **Protect access to affordable healthcare**
- **Safeguard access to nutrition programs** like CalFresh to **fight hunger**
- **Invest in children and families:**
 - **Expanded vouchers** for families to pay for childcare
 - **Retention stipends** for childcare providers
- **Guaranteed funding for childhood mental health**
- **Ensure support for in-home senior care** and people with disabilities
